

## Koutsouraki Effrosyni



She is the Coordinator of the Out-patient clinic for Multiple Sclerosis patients (since 2003) and of the Out-patient clinic for Demented patients (since 2021). She was a Visiting Senior Investigator at the Cyprus Institute of Neurology and Genetics, Visiting Professor at Frederick University and Visiting Professor at the Cyprus School of Molecular Medicine (Nicosia). In 1990, she received her Medical Degree, and in 1996 her Doctoral thesis titled "Neurotransmitters of the mossy fibers of the human cerebellar cortex: An electron microscopy study". In 2003, she became a Lecturer in Neurology, in 2008 an Assistant Professor of Neurology, in 2013 a Permanent Assistant Professor, and in 2017 an Associate Professor of Neurology-Neuroimmunology. From 2007 to 2017, she was the Head of the Neuroimmunological Laboratory of the 1st Department of Neurology. She had three Sabbaticals for 19 months in the Laboratory of Neuropathology (Eppendorf Hospital, Hamburg, Germany), in the Laboratory of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology, Pasteur Research Institute, and in the Institute of Neurology and Genetics (Nicosia). She is a teacher professor in ten postgraduate courses. She was an invited speaker at over 120 congresses and scientific meetings. She was a reviewer for more than 55 neurological journals. She participated in 20 Research programs and received 12 Prizes/ Awards.
